30 years ago, a group of South Georgia residents met at a rural park in Jeff Davis County to establish a local Chapter of the International club.


I look back on that day and recall the faces of those who attended and realize how few




This Newsletter is dedicated to the history of the

One of the big surprises was the May 21st, 1994, event that was held at Wong's Palace as seen in the May 13th, 1994,








And proudly presenting ...members of the South Georgia Chapter spending a day with the Cades. Stephen is 3rd from the right.




